Version 1.63 incorporates some minor fixes plus enhancements over the 1.62 release.

2 EXCEL COMPATIBILITY

The **SBC** is an application that runs with a legal copy of Microsoft Excel® (not supplied). A 1 GHz processor or faster is recommended for best performance.

The **SBC** has been validated in the following environments:

- Office 2000 and Office 2003 under Microsoft Windows®
- Office/X and Office 2004 under Macintosh® OS X
- Excel Office 2001 - Mac OS 9.2

The **SBC** is not supported under Office 2007 (Windows) or Office 2008 (Macintosh). The **SBC** has not been recently validated and may not work on older versions of Excel such as Office '97.

The **SBC** is not supported under OpenOffice®, NeoOffice® or derivative programs.

3 SECURITY SETTINGS

The **SBC** is implemented in Excel XLM macros. On initial launch, the user will be prompted to enable the macros to proceed. The dialog posted by Excel will vary depending on the version of Excel and the current Excel security settings. To continue, enable the macro execution. If prompted, set the security settings to medium.

The **SBC** only makes modifications to the team worksheet. The only external operations occur during creation of web page files. The user has total control over the destination of all generated files. The **SBC** is password protected to prevent corruption.

4 UPGRADING FROM PREVIOUS SBC VERSIONS

To upgrade from a previous version of the **SBC**, simply replace the existing macros file with the **SBC_Macros.xlm** file included in the 1.63 distribution package.

The **SBC** provides forward compatibility for team worksheets that were created using the original 1.50b1 release and beyond. When a previous team worksheet is first launched with the v1.63 version of the **SBC**, a series of patches will be applied to the worksheet. This may take some time depending on the speed of the processor and the previous version number. The message bar will show the progress of the patch application processing. When all the patches have been applied, the message bar will show **SBC READY**.

Once the team worksheet is saved, the patches are permanent.

The team worksheets supplied with the v1.63 release already incorporate these patches.

5 **REVISION HISTORY**

1.63: Fixes and enhancements to the 1.62 release – 021810

Note: The User Manual distributed with the 1.63 release is unchanged from the 1.62 release except for the revision number.

Enhancements

1. Modified extended preferences dialog to allow separate control of **WPC** preferences (favicon/head vs. table includes) and table includes.
2. Added capability for hyperlinks to add a target string (e.g: force link to open in new window).

Fixes

1. “Fines” edit box during player update only allowed integers. Corrected to allow fractional values.
2. Corrected problem with table trailer include.
3. Corrected problem of expansion player area during player update command sequence.
4. Corrected case when closing the stats window via the Close button on the window frame would get a macro error halt.

1.62: Fixes and enhancements to the 1.60 release – 061009

Enhancements

1. Calculate Box Score: Added RBI as a user-selectable category.
2. Web page generation: Improved web page title generation for Batting Leaders and Batting Leaders Summary pages.
3. Web page generation: Improved performance of Save Area as Web Page and Save Selection as HTML Table commands.
4. Player statistics: Added optimizer of empty slots in player roster areas for better screen visibility.

Fixes

1. Player statistics: OBPCT formulas produce an incorrect result if there were non-zero HBP entries.
2. Update Player Stats dialog: Player name field sometimes gets truncated.
3. Update Player Stats dialog: Recent player position may return an incorrect value (POS or 0 displayed) under certain situations.
4. Calculate Box Score options dialog: The check box item for Filter Innings Labels overlaps other items.
5. SBC Quit: During the prompt to save the team worksheet, if the cancel button was hit, subsequent operations may fail.
6. Keyboard escapes: Some keyboard escape mappings conflict with built-in Excel or OS mappings (See Table 2 [SBC User Manual](#) for correct mappings).
7. Keyboard escapes: cmd+O and cmd+N have no function in the **SBC** and should be blocked.
8. Web page generation: `white-space` property was not being generated.
